10.00 am Registration

Registration starts at 10.00 am in the information room at the front of the church, this is for everyone aged 4 to 18.

Each primary-age child receives a lanyard and then can take a seat in church with their family.

If it's your first time here we will ask you to fill out a registration form to help us to keep everyone safe and to be aware of allergies or other relevant information.



Our morning services are Livestreamed and appear on the internet so only let your child comes to the front of the church to join in with song actions or other activities if you are happy for them to do this.

10.15 am All together

Our main service starts at 10.15 am with a time of worship and a short all-age talk. Children and young people then leave for their various age group-based activities.

Explorers - Pre School babies and toddlers



Babies, toddlers, and children up to 3 years old meet in the Lower Lounge and can be dropped off before the service or brought out when the children & young people leave.

There are toys to play with, squash, biscuits, Bible stories, and singing time. Parents/carers can stay if they would like to, or they can return to church service.



Adventurers – 3 to 5 year-olds

Our Adventurers meet in the Walnut Suite and enjoy their story, craft time, games, and activities. There are squash and biscuits for the children during the morning.



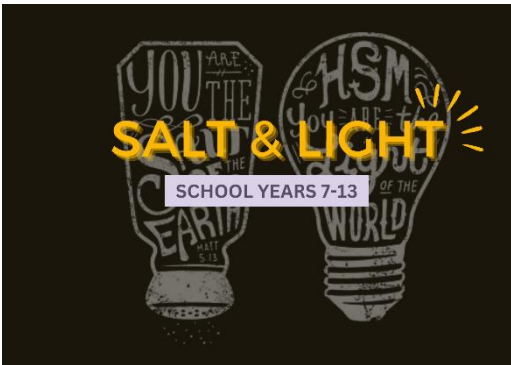
Navigators – School years 1 to 3 (age 5-8 years)

Trailblazers – School years 4 to 6 (age 8 -11 years).



Navigators and Trailblazers meet in the Memorial Hall, they have a time of teaching together with a drink and biscuit before splitting into smaller age-based groups for further discussion/teaching activities and themed crafts.

Salt & Light – School years 7 - 13
